- Friday 3rd November - **INSET Day Nursery closure**. This day will not be invoiced, as staff attend a whole company training day.
- Friday 22nd December-**Nursery closes for Christmas**
- Tuesday 2nd January-**Nursery re-opens**

What does your child need in nursery each day?

To enable children to make the most out of every nursery session, they will need to have in nursery every day:

- Any medication that they routinely need-Asthma inhalers, EpiPen injectors, antihistamine, eczema cream. These must be prescribed by a doctor and have an appropriate Health care plan in place. Please do not send in any other medication in their bags, without handing it to their keyperson. Medication must be in the original box, with the prescription label in place.
- Nappy cream-(*we no longer allow Bepanthen cream in nursery as it contains Almond oil.*)
- Enough wipes for the weeks nappy changes (we do not hold spare wipes)
- Welly boots, waterproof all in one puddle suits, waterproof jackets
- Sun hats with a peak or brim
- A warm coat for outdoor play, or layers to go under a thinner waterproof jacket
- Hats, scarves and gloves during colder months.
- Comforters, dummies etc that the child needs to go to sleep.
- Parents are advised to **not** bring toys in from home
- ALL items must be clearly labelled with the child's name

Allergies in nursery

Due to the severe effects of nut allergies, Littleworld Nurseries are **Nut free zones**.

This means that no products containing nuts are to be brought into nursery. We scrutinise all food items being used in nursery, including those brought in by parents and children.

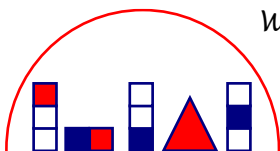
To support this, we ask that all parents check items being sent into nursery-birthday cakes, boxes of chocolates and leaving gifts etc to ensure they are nut free.
